Cllr Smith reported the latest position:

- A works order has been raised for a sound barrier
- Mr Mike Matthews is continuing with the application and an interim payment has been made of which 50% is to be reimbursed by the Parish Council to Quedgeley Social Club. If the licence application is successful it was unanimously agreed to install 3 no. benches secured to the ground outside under the canopy and the cycle rack re-positioned.
