

Waterwells Sports Centre



Waterwells Business Park was built at the end of the 1990's, as part of the planning agreement the developers provided land and capital funding of £170k to convert the green field site into a recreational sports field, at the time there were no outdoor sports facilities within this part of Gloucester and our aim was to convert the 5.7 hectare field into a fully equipped, multi use outdoor hub sports facility for the local community. A landscape design consultant (Mitchell Harris Partnership) drew up a specification for the pitch works and monitored the works through to the first year's maintenance.





Changing facilities were required to move the site forward and to allow competitive sports to take place. A grant application was made to the Football Foundation and on 8th December 2005, confirmation was received that they had agreed a grant in excess of £301k. Quedgeley Parish Council provided £20k to allow the project to be completed. Beam Construction Limited was awarded the contract, work started in October 2006 and was completed in April 2007.



Further development continued to take place within Quedgeley and again funds were secured for the site through planning gain and the Parish Council, this time an all weather training area was proposed. Tenders were received and ETC Sports Surfaces won the contract. Work started in September 2009 and was completed in October 2009. The facility is hired out to numerous clubs, is proving to be a great success and provides a much needed facility for the local community.
