Notes of the PUBLIC FORUM of Quedgeley Town Council Meeting on the 16th July 2018

Cllr Hawthorne reported the following:

- *Highways resurfacing Bristol Road from Tesco roundabout to Naas Lane roundabout.*
- *Upgrading crossing in Quedgeley and hopeful to extend to others.*
- *£700,000.00 secured funding to upgrade the tow path from Rea Bridge to town and it is hopeful another bid will be successful going in the opposite direction.*
- *Clearwater Drive appeal will be heard by public inquiry possibly in November but this is to be confirmed.*
- *3 separate sets of Traffic Regulation Orders submitted, Olympus Park, Meadowside School, Meerbrook Way new estate.*
- *S106 for Quedgeley possibly around £160,000.00 and hoping to create an open space strategy for Quedgeley and working group to look at where and how this should be spent, a representative from Quedgeley Council is welcome.*
- *Pathway improvements in Green Farm*
- *A wooden boundary fence will be erected around the new St James housing.*
