The committee raised no objections to a circular memorial bench to be provided around the oak tree located in Quedgeley Cemetery however, it must conform to all health & safety standards and be sympathetic in appearance to its surroundings. The cost of doing so will be solely the responsibility of the trust and it must be made available for use by all visitors to the cemetery.
