<b>FC.102/20-21</b>	<p><b>COMMUNITY BUILDINGS COMMITTEE</b></p> <p>Noting of Minutes dated 12<sup>th</sup> October 2020: <b>accepted by CB on 09.11.20 - noted</b> Chairman Report – Cllr Mrs McAllan agreed to offer Kingsway Sports Pavilion free of charge to allow for a Xmas Food Bank to operate over two days in December.</p> <p>A clothes recycling unit is currently available at Kingsway Sports Pavilion and agreement reached to place another unit at Quedgeley Community Centre. A small income is received from the operators of the system.</p> <p>Agreement has been reached with Hardwicke &amp; Quedgeley Cricket Club to use portable lighting for their nets to allow cricket practice to continue through the winter months. Any planning permission required to be obtained by the Club.</p> <p>The annual boiler services and fixed wire testing has been completed.</p>
