

**Grant funding available for Gloucester City Council residents to improve the energy efficiency of their homes by insulating the loft, cavity walls AND solid walls – We need your help!**

Gloucester City Council and the Warm and Well scheme now has grant funding for Solid wall insulation. Historically, there have been only small levels of funding available for properties deemed to be harder to treat, which have not been suitable for traditional cavity wall insulation.

For a limited time only, there is 100% grant funding for solid wall properties that are heated using electric or solid fuel, regardless of household income or benefit status. Properties with solid walls that use gas, oil or LPG can also qualify for discounted solid wall insulation. All grants are subject to survey and funding availability.

Warm and well works throughout Gloucestershire to improve the energy efficiency of homes and help reduce fuel bills. The scheme can help householders access grant funding through the Energy Company Obligation (ECO), a requirement placed upon energy suppliers to reduce energy use in the home and the amount of carbon dioxide that is produced.

Also, householders in receipt of one of the following benefits can potentially qualify for up to 100% grant funding towards insulating their home (loft and cavity wall insulation) and upgrading their boiler or central heating:

- State pension credit
- Income related benefits, with a child and an income of less than £15,860
- Income related benefits with a disability element

Warm and Well, with support of Gloucester City Council would like to provide information to householders, highlighting what help is now available, with Parish Council help. If there are any opportunities for leaflets to be distributed or adverts to be provided in local publications, it would be greatly appreciated. Also, any local initiatives and events that may be happening in the area can potentially be supported.
